**Question 1: Conflict of Interest**

The District already has a conflict of Interest Policy, most district and municipalities do pursuant to the Missouri Constitution and Chapter 105 RSMo. I have attached a copy of the District's current policy, but I agree with you it could be better as not only do I think the Public Financial Disclosures (PFD) should be kept in house as they currently are, they should be kept with the Missouri Ethics Commission (MEC).

The prior board was not filing their disclosures with MEC but supposedly keeping them in house. As a result when requested via a sunshine request they were not handed over by the Robertson Fire Protection District custodian of Records at the time, Former Chief Phillips. Why we do not know.

I, Jennifer Guyton, have attached a copy of my PFD as I had to complete it recently. The other board members will be available via sunshine request to RFPD or MEC.

**Question 2: Hiring, Firing practices and Conflict of Interest in contracts and services.**

The District already has hiring and firing practices that are in the employee manual.

As far as conflict of interest with contract and services, all of our contracts and services will be disclosed to the public and we have been very open about them.

As what was disclosed about our legal council. As far as our accounting services, I bring this up as I noted they were mentioned multiple times. Sikich was chosen because of their complete price and they came highly recommended by the Chief Financial Officer of the Mehlville Fire Protection District. I also reached out to West County EMS & Fire for a recommendation, however, we passed on that recommendation.

**Question 3: Termination of Employees**

It is illegal for us to public discuss or disclose personnel issues.

In the interest of transparency and public disclosure I would like to propose that the RFPD adopt a conflict of interest policy and disclosure procedure similar to that which is required by the city of Hazelwood and which ensures that all persons with positions of authority act in a manor that that is both in accordance with state laws and becoming of the office. These are defined in Chapter 125 section 010 of the City of Hazelwood Government Code, I will highlight some of them here. Disclosures of financial, legal, or administrative associations of board members, their direct family members, and any organization in which they have a "*substantial personal or private interest*" including any transactions or donations that may have been received by any of these parties within the last calendar year. I would like these disclosures to be made public and continue on a yearly basis. This will help ensure that no position be used to ensure financial or political benefit to any outside entities, including things like lucrative employment for family members or policy decision made on behalf of the interests of any of these outside entities.

I would like to propose that the RFPD adopt standardized hiring and firing practices. Firstly by demonstrating that the hiring or retention of services is free of conflicts of interest and second, per Title VIII Chapter 105 Section 454 Subsection 2 and 3 of Missouri law, that *"the transaction is made pursuant to an award on a contract let or sale made after public notice and in the case of property other than real property, competitive bidding, provided that the bid or offer accepted is the lowest received;"*

I also would like to ensure that all of the recent changes to services employed by Robertson also meet these standards and that the board will provide the information about the decision to seek other services, the contract award process, and any potential conflicts of interest by any of those newly retained individuals or entities. Specifically as it pertains to legal and accounting services but also for any other services retained by the district.

In addition to that, firing policies that define what grounds will cause an existing employee or contract to be terminated. Specific metrics and reasons that warrant termination in order to prevent termination based on personal, political, or external considerations. Also a public disclosure of those reasons in the event of a contract or personnel termination.

**RESOLUTION REGULATING REQUIREMENTS AND POLICIES  
TO DISCLOSE CONFLICTS OF INTEREST**

**WHEREAS**, section 105.485.4 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri requires certain employees, officials and candidates of certain political subdivisions of the State of Missouri (the "State"), to file financial interest statements with the Missouri Ethics Commission (the "Commission"), unless said political subdivision adopts an ordinance, order or resolution which establishes and makes public its own method of disclosing potential conflicts of interest and substantial interest; and

**WHEREAS**, on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of July 2022, the Robertson Fire Protection District (the "District") established and made public the District's chosen method of disclosing potential conflicts of interest and substantial interest in accordance with the requirements of Section 105.485.4; and

**WHEREAS**, by Opinion No. 100-93 the Commission has opined that Section 105.485.4 requires political subdivisions that wish to establish their own method of disclosing potential conflicts of interest and substantial interests to adopt an ordinance, order or resolution at an open meeting by September 15th, biennially, and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Robertson Fire Protection District desires to abide by 105.485.4 RSMo.:

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF  
THE ROBERTSON FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT, AS FOLLOWS:**

**CONFLICTS OF INTEREST AND FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE**

The Proper operation of government requires that public officials and employees be independent, impartial and responsible to the people; that government decisions and policy be made in the proper channels of the governmental structure; that public office not be used for personal gain; and that the public have confidence in the integrity of its government. In recognition of these goals, there is hereby established a procedure for disclosure by certain officials and employees of private financial or other interests in matters affecting the Fire District.

**I. Definitions.**

The following terms shall have the following meanings:

(A) *Adversary proceeding.* Any proceedings in which a record of the proceedings may be kept and maintained as a public record at the request of either party by a court reporter, notary public or some other person authorized to keep such record by law or any rule or regulation of the District conducting the hearing; or from which an appeal may be taken directly or indirectly, or any proceeding from the decision of which any party may be granted, on request a hearing de novo; or a proceeding of a personnel review board; or an investigative proceeding initiated by an official, department, division which pertains to matters which, depending on the conclusion of the investigation, could lead to a judicial or administrative proceeding being initiated against the party by the official, department or division.

(B) *Business entity.* A corporation, association, firm, partnership, proprietorship or business entity of any kind or character.

(C) *Business with which one is associated:*

(1) Any sole proprietorship owned by oneself, one's spouse or any dependent children; or

(2) Any partnership or joint venture in which one or one's spouse is a partner, other than a limited partner, any corporation or limited partnership in which one is an officer or director or of which either one or one's spouse or dependent child in one's custody whether singularly or collectively owns in excess of ten (10) percent of the outstanding shares of any class of stock or partnership units; or

(3) An interest having a value of \$10,000 or more;

(4) Any trust as to which one is a trustee or settler or in which one or one's spouse or dependent child whether singularly or collectively is a beneficiary or holder of a reversionary interest of ten (10) percent or more of the corpus of the trust.

(D) *Commission.* The Missouri Ethics Commission established pursuant to state law.

(E) *Confidential information.* All information whether transmitted orally or in writing which is of such a nature that it is not, at that time, a matter of public record or public knowledge.

(F) *Decision-making public servant.* An official, appointee or employee of the Fire District who exercises supervisory authority over the negotiation of contracts, or has the legal authority to adopt or vote on the adoption of rules and regulations with the force of law or exercises primary supervisory responsibility over purchasing decisions and is

designated as a decision-making public servant by the board.

(G) *Dependent child.* All children, stepchildren, foster children and wards under the age of eighteen (18) residing in one's household and who receive in excess of fifty (50) percent of their support from the individual.

(H) *Substantial or private interest.* Ownership by the individual, the individual's spouse, or the individual's dependent children, whether singularly or collectively, directly or indirectly, of ten (10) percent or more of any business entity, or of an interest having a value of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) or more, or the receipt by an individual, the individual's spouse or the individual's dependent children, whether singularly or collectively, of a salary, gratuity, or other compensation or remuneration of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00), or more, per year from any individual, partnership, organization, or association within any calendar year.

(I) *Substantial personal or private interest in any measure, bill, order or ordinance.* Any interest in a measure, bill, resolution, order or ordinance which results from a substantial interest in a business entity.

## II. Prohibited actions; administrative officials.

No elected or appointed official or employee of the District, serving in an administrative capacity, shall:

(A) Perform any service for the District over which the officer or employee has supervisory power for receipt of any compensation, other than the compensation provided for the performance of one's official duties, in excess of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) per annum, except on transactions made pursuant to an award on a contract let or sale made after public notice and competitive bidding; or

(B) Sell, rent or lease any property to the District over which the officer or employee has supervisory power and received consideration therefore in excess of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) per year unless the transaction is made pursuant to an award on a contract let or sale made after public notice and in the case of property other than real property and competitive bidding; or

(C) Participate in any matter, directly or indirectly, in which the officer or employee attempts to influence any decision of the District over which the officer or employee has supervisory power, when the officer or employee knows the result of such decision may be the acceptance of the performance of a service or the sole, rental or lease of any property to the District for consideration in excess of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) value per annum to the officer or employee, to his or her spouse, to a dependent child in his or her custody or to any business with which the officer or employee is associated, unless the transaction is made pursuant to an award on a contract let or sale made after public notice and in the case of property other than real property, competitive bidding, provided that the bid or offer accepted is the lowest received; or



**(D) Perform any service for consideration, during one (1) year after termination of his office or employment, by which the officer or employee attempts to influence a decision of the District over which the officer or employee had supervisory power, except that this provision shall not be construed to prohibit any person from performing such service and receiving compensation therefore, in any adversary proceeding or in the preparation or filing of any public document or to prohibit an employee of one department of the District from being employed by another department of the District; or**

**(E) Perform any service for any consideration for any person, firm or corporation after termination of the officer's term or the employee's employment in relation to any case, decision, proceeding or application with respect to which the officer or employee was directly concerned or in which the officer or employee personally participated during the period of his or her service or employment.**

**III. Prohibited acts; members of the Board of Directors.**

**(A) No member of the Board of Directors shall:**

- (1) Perform any service for the District thereof for any consideration other than the compensation provided for the performance of one's official duties; or**
- (2) Sell, rent or lease any property to the District for consideration in excess of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) per annum unless the transaction is made pursuant to an award on a contract let or sale made after public notice and in the case of property other than real property and competitive bidding; or**
- (3) Participate in any matter, directly or indirectly, in which the officer or employee attempts to influence any decision of the District over which the officer or employee has supervisory power, when the officer or employee knows the result of such decision may be the acceptance of the performance of a service or the sole, rental or lease of any property to the District for consideration in excess of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) value per annum to the officer or employee, to his or her spouse, to a dependent child in his or her custody or to any business with which the officer or employee is associated, unless the transaction is made pursuant to an award on a contract let or sale made after public notice and in the case of property other than real property, competitive bidding, provided that the bid or offer accepted is the lowest received; or**
- (4) Attempt, for any compensation other than the compensation provided for the performance of one's official duties, to influence the decision of the District on any matter; except that, this provision shall not be construed to prohibit such person from participating for compensation in any adversary proceeding or in the preparation or filing of any public document or conference thereon; or**

- (5) Provide any professional service(s), with or without compensation, for the District regardless of the nature.
  - (6) Utilize any professional services firm, business, LLC, etc. or individual engaged by and/or representing the District for their personal representation or services.
  - (7) Accept any gifts, monetary or non-monetary, from any individual, business, civic, fraternal, etc. type organizations that conduct business with the District or has any type of written agreement with the District.
- (B) No sole proprietorship, partnership, joint venture, or corporation in which any member of the board of directors is a sole proprietor, a partner having more than ten (10) percent partnership interest; or a participant or owner of in excess of ten (10) percent of the outstanding shares in any class of stock, shall:
- (1) Perform any service for the District thereof for any consideration in excess of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) per annum unless the transaction is made pursuant to an award on a contract let after public notice and competitive bidding; or
  - (2) Sell, rent or lease any property to the District where the consideration is in excess of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) per annum unless the transaction is made pursuant to an award on a contract let or sale made after public notice and in the case of property other than real property, competitive bidding, provided that the bid or offer accepted is the lowest received.
  - (3) Participate in any matter, directly or indirectly, in which the officer or employee attempts to influence any decision of the District over which the officer or employee has supervisory power, when the officer or employee knows the result of such decision may be the acceptance of the performance of a service or the sole, rental or lease of any property to the District for consideration in excess of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) value per annum to the officer or employee, to his or her spouse, to a dependent child in his or her custody or to any business with which the officer or employee is associated, unless the transaction is made pursuant to an award on a contract let or sale made after public notice and in the case of property other than real property, competitive bidding, provided that the bid or offer accepted is the lowest received; or

**IV. Disclosure of interest required.**

Each elected official, candidate for elective office, the chief administrative officer, and the chief purchasing officer shall disclose the following information by May 1, or the

appropriate deadline as referenced in Section 105.487 RSMo, if any such transactions occurred during the previous calendar year:

- a. For such person, and all persons within the first degree of consanguinity or affinity of such person, the date and the identities of the parties to each transaction with a total value in excess of five hundred dollars, if any, that such person had with the political subdivision, other than compensation received as an employee or payment of any tax, fee or penalty due to the political subdivision, and other than transfers for no consideration to the political subdivision.
- b. The date and the identities of the parties to each transaction known to the person with a total value in excess of five hundred dollars, if any, that any business entity in which such person had a substantial interest, had with the political subdivision, other than payment of any tax, fee or penalty due to the political subdivision or transactions involving payment for providing utility service to the political subdivision, and other than transfers for no consideration to the political subdivision.
- c. The chief administrative officer, chief purchasing officer, and candidates for either of these positions also shall disclose by May 1, or the appropriate deadline as referenced in Section 105.487, RSMo. the following information for the previous calendar year:
  1. The name and address of each of the employers of such person from whom income of one thousand dollars or more was received during the year covered by the statement;
  2. The name and address of each sole proprietorship that he/she owned; the name address and the general nature of the business conducted of each general partnership and joint venture in which he was a partner or participant; the name and address of each partner or co-participant for each partnership or joint venture unless such names and addresses are filed by the partnership or joint venture with the secretary of state; the name, address and general nature of the business conducted of any closely held corporation or limited partnership in which the person owned ten percent or more of any class of the outstanding stock or limited partnership units; and the name of any publicly traded corporation or limited partnership that is listed on a regulated stock exchange or automated quotation system in which the person owned two percent or more of any class or outstanding stock, limited partnership units or other equity interests;
  3. The name and address of each corporation for which such person served in the capacity of a director, officer, or receiver

**V. Prohibited acts; persons with rulemaking authority.**

(A) No member of the District who is empowered to adopt a rule or regulation, other than rules and regulations governing the internal affairs of the District, or who is empowered to fix any rate, adopt zoning or land use planning regulations or plans, or who participates in or votes on the adoption of any such rule, regulation, rate or plan, shall:

(1) Attempt to influence the decision or participate, directly or indirectly, when he or she knows the result of such decision may be the adoption of rates or zoning plans which may result in a direct financial gain or loss to such member, the member's spouse or a dependent child in the member's custody or to any business with which the member is associated; or

(2) Perform any service, during the member's term, for any person, firm or corporation for compensation other than the compensation provided for the performance of the member's official duties, if by the performance of the service the member attempts to influence the decision of the District; or

(3) Perform for one (1) year after termination of the member's term any service for compensation for any person, firm or corporation to influence the decision or action of the District; provided, however, that he or she may, after termination of his or her office or employment, perform such service for consideration in any adversary proceeding or in the preparation or filing of any public document or conference thereon unless he or she participated directly in that matter or in the receipt or analysis of that document while serving as a member.

(B) No such member or any business with which such member is associated shall knowingly perform any service for, or sell, rent or lease any property to any person, firm or corporation which has participated in any proceeding in which the member adopted, participated in the adoption or voted on the adoption of any rate or zoning plan or the granting or revocation of any license during the preceding year and received therefore in excess of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) per annum except on transaction pursuant to an award on a contract let or sale made after public notice and in the case of property other than real property, competitive bidding, provided that the bid or offer accepted is the lowest received.

**VI. Filing of Reports**

A. The financial interest statements shall be filed at the following times, but no person is required to file more than one financial interest statement in any calendar year;

1. Every person required to file a financial interest statement shall file the statement annually not later than May 1 and the statement shall cover the calendar year ending the immediately preceding December 31; provided that any member of the (council/board) may supplement the financial interest statement to report additional interests acquired after December 31 of the covered year until the date of filing of the financial interest statement.
  2. Each person appointed to office shall file the statement within thirty days of such appointment or employment covering the calendar year ending the previous December 31;
  3. Every candidate required to file a personal financial disclosure statement shall file no later than fourteen days after the close of filing at which the candidate seeks nomination or election or nomination by caucus. The time period of this statement shall cover the twelve months prior to the closing date of filing for candidacy.
- B. Financial disclosure reports giving the financial information required in Section VI shall be filed with Robertson Fire Protection District.

The reports shall be available for public inspection and copying during normal business hours.

#### **VII. Exceptions.**


- (A) No provisions of these sections shall be construed to prohibit any person from performing any ministerial act or any act required by order of a court of law to be performed.
- (B) No provisions of these sections shall be construed to prohibit any person from communicating with the office of the attorney general or any prosecuting attorney or any attorney for the Fire District concerning any prospective claim or complaint then under consideration not otherwise prohibited, by law.
- (C) No provisions of these sections shall be construed to prohibit any person, firm, or corporation from receiving compensation for property taken by the District under the power of eminent domain in accord with the provisions of the Missouri Constitution, the laws of the State of Missouri.
- (D) No provisions of these sections shall be construed to prohibit any person, firm or Corporation from providing professional services to any employee of the district or providing products or consultation for just compensation relative to the product or service provided. In no event shall private or confidential information be disseminated in abrogation of any applicable rule, regulation or statute.


