

Good Afternoon

On 12-24-23 around 0300 Pvt. Hansen was responding to a call in 5017. While exiting the engine bay 5017 came in contact with 5014s captain door causing it to over extend. Pvt. Hansen continued to the call and upon arrival called to report the incident to Capt. Grimwood. I then went out to the engine bay to investigate the damage. The door did appear to have been over extended and would not close. I called Central County and took 5014 out of service, then notified BC Herman of the incident and requested he come to House 1. I then loosened the door hinge of 5014 and re-adjusted to allow the door to close. I was successful in temporarily repairing the door. I took pictures of all the affected areas of 5014. 5017 returned to find a dent to the oxygen compartment door and vent, a cracked lense of the emergency light along with a couple scratches down the driver side. I took pictures of all the damage. BC Herman arrived to obtain all of the appropriate paperwork. Pvt. Hansen was interviewed to confirm the timeline of events. Pvt. Hansen stated he did not realize the wheels of 5017 were cut towards 5014 and before he could correct the wheels he had come in contact with the apparatus door. We have taken actions to prevent this from happening again by ensuring the apparatus doors are shut when in the engine bay and all turnout gear is stored away from the floor to ensure plenty of clearance for both apparatus. Please see attached images of the damage and incident report.

The wheels on 5017 were turned to the left when the vehicle was parked.

What are contributing factors to the injury/accident? Specify other contributing hazardous factors. Was employee utilizing correct lifting techniques? Was there an error in judgment? Was proper supervision provided? Did employee receive adequate training?

5017 was parked closely to 5014 and the wheels were cocked to the left when 5017 was parked.

What corrective actions to prevent similar incidents? What actions have you taken to prevent similar accidents?

Firefighter Hansen will ensure vehicle has adequate room to leave the bay prior to departing the engine bay in the future, and will take his time to ensure safe operations of his apparatus.
