

ABSTRACT: A new American flag is needed for the new ladder truck to replace the dirty flag that no longer suits our needs.

PROBLEM: The current flag we have is dirty and hangs from the fire truck like it is on a flag pole. The correct way to hang an American flag on a fire truck is garrison style with the blue field up and the stripes pointing down (see pictures)

ADVANTAGE: This is the correct way to fly the flag on fire trucks. This is specifically made in USA for fire trucks with multiple mounting eyelets, weighted bottom ends so flag does not flap uncontrollably in the wind. The flag has reinforced corners and multiple eyelets for mounting on a pole.

PROPOSED SYSTEM: Purchase new American 15 x 25 flag from Flag center in Tennessee I will build the support pole from items we have left over and new hardware not to exceed \$100.00 (I will make the needed flag support in my home shop)

COSTS: \$1085.00 free shipping plus max \$100.00 for hardware total cost 1185.00(closest next bid was 1800.00 from flagman and not as many options as above flag.)

COST RECOVERY: Pride and Honor, non-monetary.



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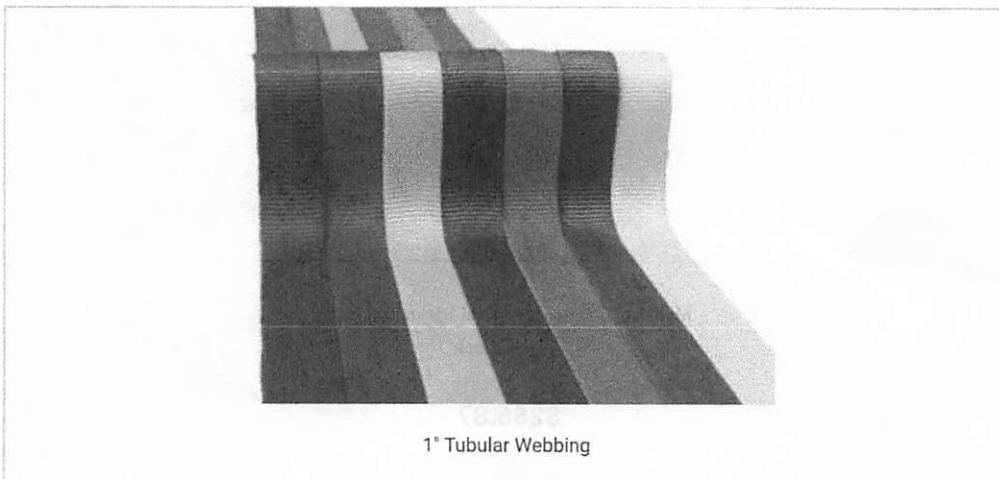

This letter is the MO HealthNet Division's (MHD's) official notification of your GEMT Supplement Reimbursement overpayment that must be repaid to MHD for State Fiscal Year (SFY) 2021. According to 13 CSR 70-6.020, MHD will audit and reconcile the as-filed cost report with paid claims data and provider records to determine that a GEMT provider's uncompensated Medicaid costs are reimbursed through the GEMT Supplement Reimbursement Program. MHD has completed the SFY 2021 GEMT audit and reconciliation, and the final results for you are enclosed and reflected in this letter.

Based on the results of the GEMT audit and reconciliation below, your SFY 2021 interim GEMT Supplement Reimbursement payments exceeded your uncompensated Medicaid costs for GEMT services. The GEMT Supplement Reimbursement amount below is an overpayment and must be repaid to MHD.

If any such petition is sent by registered mail or certified mail, the petition will be deemed filed on the date it is mailed. If any such petition is sent by any method other than registered mail or certified mail, it will be deemed filed on the date it is received by the commission.

Compliance with this decision does not absolve the provider from any criminal liability related to the medical assistance program (MO HealthNet) activity that may be brought by any authorized agency.
